## **MEMBERSHIP**

- Developed vision and mission statements
- Created our logo

## RESPONSE

- Drug Overdose Response Team (DORT) is operational with 44 successful connections with those who overdosed
- Established overdose alerts which when activated are sent via text, shared on social media, and shared on BAS broadcasting radio stations
- Developed www.narcanerieohio.com to offer free mail-ordered Narcan
- 1671 Narcan kits distributed
- 240 known Narcan reversals



## **RECOVERY**

- ECHD secured additional funding to pilot a near real-time treatment finder (FindHelpNow)
  - Developed 5 phases for onboarding to FindHelpNow platform
- Created a request for application for interested treatment providers
- Engaged BGSU Firelands students in the process through the use of a script to reach out to treatment providers
