

Strategic Action Plan 21-22

Overview

The *vision* of the Tobacco Action Coalition is to have a community free of nicotine addiction and the harmful associated effects.

The mission of the Tobacco Action Coalition is to increase access to cessation resources for those who are ready to quit tobacco, decrease secondhand smoke exposure, and reduce tobacco initiation within Erie County.

Intermediate Objectives:

- https:// Decrease accessibility and availability of tobacco products to youth within Erie County.
- ♣ Decrease the number of people exposed to secondhand smoke in public spaces or multi-unit housing.
- increase accessibility and utilization of cessation services for both adults and youth.
- ** Reduce disparities relating to tobacco use within Erie County for individuals with low socioeconomic status.

Project Objectives:

- **Youth: By June 30, 2022, a community project focused on reducing youth vaping within Erie County will be completed and a POS policy to pursue will be identified.
- ** Policy: By June 30, 2022, a policy will be passed to decrease the number of individuals exposed to secondhand smoke in public spaces or multi-unit housing.
- **Cessation:** By June 30, 2022, a community project focused on encouraging cessation for current tobacco users within Erie County will be completed.
- Equity: By June 30, 2022, at least 12 workgroup meetings involving members from five separate sectors will be held to discuss and address tobacco use for individuals with low socioeconomic status. The sectors include: Education, Law Enforcement, Business, Government, Health/Medical Professional, Housing, Involved Citizen, Faith-Based, Civic Associations, Media, Community Organizations. These meetings will result in the creation of a 5 year strategic plan to address this issue.
